Follow-Up to Questions at the September 22 meeting of the
2023 Special Committee on Nursing Facility Reimbursement Rate Methodology*

1. What were the rates and appropriations in 2012/2013 for the PD/FE/BI waiver case management services?

In SFY12, the expenditures for Targeted Case Management for FE, PD and BI populations are listed below:

TCM/PD: 5.2 million AF (2.2 million SGF)

TCM/BI: 692K AF (295K SGF)

TCM/FE: 5.3 million AF (2.3 million SGF)

Below were the last rates for TCM for the following populations.

TCM/BI: T1017: \$10.60

TCM/PD: T1017: \$10.60

TCM/FE: T1017 - \$10.83

2. Were the services no longer offered due to the transition to managed care? If so, why were the services no longer offered?

In 2013 and the transition from Fee For Service to Managed Care, Targeted Case Management was removed for these populations and replaced with Care Coordination provided by the MCOs. Around SFY19, the legislature appropriated funding to KDADS to cover former TCM tasks not covered/allowed to be completed by MCOs through care coordination. This program is known as Administrative Case Management (ACM) and provides case management services to individuals to support the eligibility process that was previously provided through TCM.
