AN ACT concerning certain statewide elected officials; prohibiting outside employment or income to the office holder or officer holder's family. 2

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) An official elected to statewide office shall not receive 5 6 any income from outside employment, or for any other outside activity, 7 while holding such statewide office. Such an official shall not perform outside employment or activities while in office for income to be deferred 8 9 until after leaving statewide office.

(b) As used in this section, "income" means any source or type of 10 11 compensation, remuneration or payment to the office holder or any 12 member of the office holder's family, whether in the form of monetary 13 payment, payment of expenses for lodging, food and travel, equity or 14 ownership interests of any type, and providing products or services at no cost or less than market cost. 15

16 (c) The office holder shall maintain and provide for public disclosure all records relating to compensation received for all outside activity. 17

18 (d) All statewide office holders shall be considered full-time 19 employees of the state of Kansas and may not perform work for any entity, 20 person or client other than the state of Kansas, whether on a compensated 21 or non-compensated basis.

22 (e) "Statewide office holder" means the governor, attorney general, 23 secretary of state, state treasurer and commissioner of insurance.

24 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 25 publication in the statute book.
