Agency Estimate

The **agency** requests a revised estimate of \$1,397,329, all from the Credit Union Fee Fund, in expenditures and 12.0 FTE positions in FY 2024. This is an increase of \$90,000, or 6.9 percent, above the FY 2024 approved amount. The increase is due to the agency's request for supplemental funding for in-state travel expenses. As the pandemic wanes, the agency plans to have each of its eight financial examiners travel 26 weeks per year to conduct on-site examinations of credit unions. (*Note*: In recent years, the agency has expended less than their approved budget and, as such, does not anticipate increasing any fees to accomplish its goal of conducting more on-site examinations.)
