

-The NDAA law signed into being by Barack Obama on Dec 31 2011 contains within it some of the most dangerous violations to Our Constitution to date.

-It circumvents the Treason clause by removing due process of law from the prosecution process. It places our Kansas Citizens on the same level as combatants on the battlefield.

-It removes the core value in American jurisprudence of Innocent until proven guilty, and provides for the use of military might and unlimited detention.

-No representation is secured in the legislation for supposed violators and no definition of what can be used to define a violation is provided.

-Virginia passed a resolution negating the harmful sections of this Law, just as we are asking you to protect Kansas by passing our resolution.

-While testimony in Virginia was given by Delegate Barbara Comstock against the resolution, it became apparent to me what type of attitudes are being fostered in the these proceedings by the opposition, She basically said that the State legislators do not have any business questioning the federal government or it's actions. I assume all of the Founding Fathers are rolling in their graves at this time.

-Duties of citizens in this Constitutional Republic and ALL citizens must question the actions of their elected officials. -I read the Congressional Report on the NDAA and on one line it states this would not be used on American citizens. I submit that when laws are not specifically defined and limited, they will eventually used in a the manner previously feared. Example, the income tax was originally promised to only be used in time of war or national emergency to fund the immediate need. They lied! This current administration has a history of lies and we must not give them any powers that can be used to further dismantle Our Constitutional Republic.

-There are now 1271 gov agencies and 1931 private agencies working on security and are located in 10,000 locations in the U.S. The NSA is building the world's largest surveillance program code-named "Stellar Wind" and has established methods to collect, store, and examine billions of emails and phone calls.
