SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2640 by House Committee on General Government Budget

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2640 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2640 would allow discrimination complaints to be filed electronically by facsimile or an e-mailed scanned copy with the Kansas Human Rights Commission. The bill would also allow other case materials to be submitted electronically to the Commission. The submitter of any electronic material must retain the original submission for five years after the Commission closes the case.

The Kansas Human Rights Commission does not anticipate incurring additional costs from the passage of HB 2640. If costs do occur, the Commission states that they could be absorbed within existing agency resources.
