HB 2650 - Designation of the state rock, mineral, and gemstone.

House Bill No. 2650 (HB 2650) designates the state rock, mineral, and gemstone. Section 1 of the bill designates limestone as the state rock. Section 2 designates galena as the state mineral. Section 3 designates jelinite amber as the state gemstone.

If enacted the provisions of HB 2650 would be effective on July 1, 2018.
