

To the Kansas State Legislature,

My husband and I strongly support HB 2641. In the recent past, my neighbors in Wyandotte County have been awakened by shaking cabinets. To my knowledge this was a first, and I am 75. If the injection of water into the ground is responsible, it should be strongly regulated so that things don't worsen.

Already reduced injection of water has reduced earthquakes in five counties in Kansas. From 2016 to 2017 Oklahoma saw a 58% reduction in earthquakes due to a similar bill.

It would be unconscionable not to proceed with a bill that will help prevent damaging earthquakes in Kansas, property damage, and injury to Kansans caused by major earthquakes.
