Subject: SB 262; Authorizing the construction of a statue honoring Dwight D.

Eisenhower.

Senate Bill No. 262 requires the capitol preservation committee to approve plans to place a permanent statue of Dwight D. Eisenhower on the state capitol grounds and authorizes the secretary of administration to receive moneys from any grants, gifts, contributions or bequests made for the purpose of financing the creation and construction of the statue and its pedestal and to expend such moneys for such purpose. No public funds shall be expended for the purpose of financing the creation or construction of the statue and its pedestal.

All moneys received by the secretary of administration shall be deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the Dwight D. Eisenhower statue fund. The fund is established in subsection (c) of the bill. Expenditures from the fund may be made for the purposes of creating and constructing the statue and its pedestal and for such other purposes as may be specified with regard to any grant, gift, contribution or bequest.

If the committee decides to take action on the bill, a technical amendment is needed to correct the name of the fund in line 16 to be consistent with the fund name as established in lines 19-20.
