Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 25-101a is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-101a. (a) On the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November in 1978, and each four years thereafter, there shall be elected a governor and lieutenant governor running together, a secretary of state, an attorney general, a state treasurer and a state commissioner of insurance.

- (b) Every candidate for the office of secretary of state, attorney general, state treasurer and or state commissioner of insurance shall be a qualified elector of the state of Kansas by the deadline for filing for such office as provided in K.S.A. 25-205, and amendments thereto.
- (c) Every candidate for the office of governor and lieutenant governor shall be a qualified elector and shall have been a Kansasresident for at least four consecutive years prior to becoming such acandidate and shall be 30 years of age or older at the time of becoming a candidate for such office.
- {(d) Every candidate for the office of attorney general must be licensed to practice law within the state of Kansas.}
- 21 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-101a is hereby repealed.
