1 AN ACT concerning the legislature; relating to bills introduced by
2 committees; requirements for printed bills and committee minutes;
3 committee bills requested by legislator on behalf of other person, state
4 or local agency, organization or entity.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. (a) For any bill approved for introduction and sponsored
8 by any standing committee of either house of the legislature, the
9 committee chairperson shall keep or have the committee secretary keep
10 minutes of meetings that include the legislator or other person, state or
11 local agency, organization or entity that requested the bill for introduction
12 by the committee.

13 (b) For any bill sponsored by any standing committee of either house
14 of the legislature, in addition to the sponsor of the bill, the printed version
15 of the bill shall include the legislator or other person, state or local agency,
16 organization or entity that requested the bill for introduction by the
17 committee. If a legislator requested the bill for introduction by the
18 committee on behalf of a person, state or local agency, organization or
19 entity, the printed version of the bill shall include the legislator and the
20 person, state or local agency, organization or entity that the bill was
21 requested on behalf of by such legislator, if identified by the legislator.

22 (c) When a substitute bill is recommended by a committee or the
23 committee recommends amendments to a bill that strike all of the material
24 in the bill subsequent to the enacting clause and inserts new material, the
25 printed version of such bill shall provide the committee recommending the
26 substitute bill or such amendments as the sponsor of the bill to replace the
27 original sponsor, and any legislator or other person, state or local agency,
28 organization or entity required to be included on the printed version of the
29 bill pursuant to subsection (b), shall be removed.

30 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
31 publication in the statute book.
