AN ACT concerning crimes, punishment and criminal procedure; relating
 to controlled substances; immunity from prosecution for seeking
 medical assistance.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. (a) A person and, if applicable, one or two other persons 7 acting in concert with such person are immune from criminal prosecution 8 for a violation of K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 21-5706 or 21-5709(b), and 9 amendments thereto, and any city ordinance or county resolution 10 prohibiting the acts prohibited by K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 21-5706 or 21-5709(b), and amendments thereto, if such person:

(1) (A) Initiated contact with law enforcement or emergency medical
 services and requested medical assistance on such person's behalf because
 such person reasonably believed such person was in need of medical
 assistance; and

(B) cooperated with emergency medical services personnel and lawenforcement officers in providing such medical assistance;

(2) (A) initiated contact with law enforcement or emergency medical
services, or was one of one or two other persons who acted in concert with
such person, and requested medical assistance for another person who
reasonably appeared to be in need of medical assistance;

(B) provided such person's full name, the name of one or two other
 persons acting in concert with such person, if applicable, and any other
 relevant information requested by law enforcement or emergency medical
 services;

(C) remained at the scene with the person who reasonably appeared
 to be in need of medical assistance until emergency medical services
 personnel and law enforcement officers arrived; and

(D) cooperated with emergency medical services personnel and law
 enforcement officers in providing such medical assistance; or

(3) (A) was the person who reasonably appeared to be in need of
medical assistance as described in subsection (a)(2)(A); and

(B) cooperated with emergency medical services personnel and lawenforcement officers in providing such medical assistance.

35 (b) A person shall not be allowed to initiate or maintain an action 36 against a law enforcement officer, or such officer's employer, based on the

- 1 compliance or failure to comply with this section.
- (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to anyone seeking
 medical assistance during the course of the execution of an arrest warrant
- medical assistance during the course of the execution of an arrest warrantor search warrant or a lawful search.
- 5 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 6 publication in the statute book.
