AN ACT concerning state highways; relating to the secretary of 1 2 transportation; use of rights-of-way; amending K.S.A. 68-413b and 3 repealing the existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 68-413b is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-6 413b. All rights-of-way of state highways shall be used exclusively for 7 8 public highway purposes: *Provided*, but the secretary of transportation 9 may shall authorize-such other uses of such rights-of-way-as will notinterfere with public travel thereon and which by a public utility, as 10 11 defined in K.S.A. 66-104, and amendments thereto, in a competitively 12 neutral and nondiscriminatory manner, that are in conformity with 13 applicable state and federal laws, law and rules and regulations relating to 14 highways, unless the secretary of transportation determines that such use will interfere with public travel on such highways. The secretary of 15 16 transportation is authorized to remove unauthorized structures, objects and facilities which are located upon the rights-of-way of state highways. 17 18 Nothing herein shall be construed to affect the rights of public utilities and 19 persons or associations maintaining facilities on state highway rights-of-

- way pursuant to law. Sec. 2. K.S.A. 68-413b is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
