Adding a Public Defender to the Criminal Justice Reform Commission

Members of the House Committee on Corrections & Juvenile Justice:

The Criminal Justice Reform Commission began meeting in August of 2019 with a specific charge to look at various aspects of the system and make recommendations the entire legislative body might consider to benefit the state. Part of our responsibility was to provide an interim report with recommendations for the 2020 session. This bill is one of many recommendations from the commission.

The law creating the commission specifically allows for **EITHER** a criminal defense attorney or public defender to be a voting member of the task force. The Governor chose to have a defense attorney as her appointment.
