

Testimony of the Kansas Association of Counties to the House Committee on Taxation Neutral Testimony on HB 2576 • February 18, 2020

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for allowing the Kansas Association of Counties to offer testimony on HB 2576, which would move the date by which tax statements must be mailed to taxpayers from December 15 each year to December 10.

The greatest concern that KAC has when looking at changing statutory dates by which tasks must be completed is how that change will affect other work that is done in various county offices, and how that change in workflow might alter the demands on staff time and resources. This is particularly true when the change is isolated to one date, with no corresponding change to other dates.

Before adopting such a change, the committee should carefully consider the problem that this change seeks to address, and then determine if this change remedies that problem without creating other problems in its wake. Thank you for your time and consideration.
