SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2470 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2470 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2470 would amend current law to require the receiving jurisdiction and all parties to concur with the transfer of jurisdiction of a defendant who is on probation, under supervision by community corrections, or under a suspended sentence. It would also permit the transfer of supervision of offenders in a drug treatment program to another court while having the option of retaining or transferring jurisdiction to the receiving court.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates any fiscal effect on revenues or expenditures of the Judicial Branch associated with HB 2470 would be negligible.
