AN ACT concerning employment security law; relating to lessor
 employment units and lessee clients; restrictions on leasing certain
 employees; amending K.S.A. 44-758 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 44-758 is hereby amended to read as follows: 44-7 758. (a) Any employer or any individual, organization, partnership, 8 corporation or other legal entity which that is a lessor employing unit, as 9 defined by-subsection (ff) of K.S.A. 44-703(ff), and amendments thereto, 10 shall be liable for contributions on wages paid by the lessor employing 11 unit to individuals performing services for client lessees. For the purposes 12 of the employment security law, no elient lessee shall lease an individual 13 proprietor, partner or corporate officer, who is a shareholder or a member 14 of the board of directors of the corporation, from any lessor employing unit. Any client lessee shall be jointly and severally liable for any unpaid 15 16 contributions, interest and penalties due under this law from any lessor employing unit attributable to wages for services performed for the client 17 18 lessee by employees leased to the client lessee. The lessor employing unit 19 shall keep separate records and submit separate quarterly contributions and 20 wage reports for each client lessee.

(b) Any lessor employing unit-which that is currently engaged in the
 business of leasing employees to client lessees shall comply with the
 provisions of subsection (a) prior to October 1, 1990.

(c) The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to private
employment agencies which *that* provide temporary workers to employers
on a temporary help basis, provided the private employment agencies are
liable as employers for the payment of contributions on wages paid to
temporary workers so employed.
