Subject: House Bill No. 2316

Summary

House Bill No. 2316 would repeal K.S.A. 16a-2-403 which is the statute dealing with financial transactions that prohibits sellers from imposing a surcharge when a credit or debit card is used to make a purchase. Repealing the statute would allow for the imposition of a surcharge by sellers.

The remaining sections of the bill remove references and exemptions to this repealed statute that would no longer apply.
