Subject: Senate Bill No. 98

Summary

Senate Bill No. 98 provides for the standard of evidence required from a BOTA appeal, extends the time allowed for a former member to serve and provides for the appointment of a protempore member.

<u>Section 1</u> – provides that for a taxpayer that appeals a decision of the board of tax appeals to district court based on a determination of valuation of real property, the county appraiser is required to produce evidence the validity and correctness of such valuation.

<u>Section 2</u> – extends the time period a member of the board may continue to serve after the expiration of the term from 90 to 180 days. Additionally, the Governor is allowed to appoint a former member to the Board of Tax Appeals as a member pro tempore of the Board for a period of time not to exceed one year if after having exercised due diligence, a vacancy on the Board exists.
