## **Summary**

House Bill No. 2558 would provide a Kansas income tax subtraction modification for amounts contributed to the state board of pharmacy as a donation, gift or bequest made to the board for furthering any phase of the prescription monitoring program.

The subtraction modification would become effective for tax year 2022 and thereafter.
