Subject: Bill Brief – SB 26

SB 26 designates a portion of K-7 highway as the Senator Bud Burke Memorial Highway.

SB 26 provides that the portion of K-7 from the junction of K-7 and K-10 in Johnson county, then south on K-7 to the junction of K-7 and west Santa Fe street is hereby designated as the Senator Bud Burke Memorial Highway. Highway signs designating the highway as the Senator Bud Burke Memorial Highway will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the secretary of transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways until receiving sufficient money from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.
