



**House Transportation Committee  
Testimony in Support of SB67  
Adam Lusker  
March 11, 2021**

Mr. Chairman and members of the House Transportation Committee:

My name is Adam Lusker with Federico // Duerst Consulting Group. It is my pleasure to appear in support of SB67 on behalf of Polaris, Inc.

SB 67 changes the definition for ATV 's (all terrain vehicles) and ROV's (recreational off-highway vehicles) in Kansas statute. The changes are as follows:

In K.S.A. 8- 126 (a), "All-terrain vehicle "means any motorized non-highway vehicle ~~50"~~55" or less in width *measured from the tire rim to outside of the tire rim*, having a dry weight of 1500 pounds or less and traveling on three or more non-highway tires.

In K.S.A. 8-126 (hh), "Recreational off- highway" means any motor vehicle ~~more than 50 inch but not greater than 64"~~75" and width *measured from outside of the rim to outside of the rim*, having a dry weight of ~~2000~~ 3500 pounds or less, traveling on four or more non highway tires.

This will align the definition in Kansas statute with the new industry standards which are transforming to meet consumer demands, which include:

- Increased safety and innovation
- Addresses Agricultural and Sportsmen's needs
- Keeping pace with the booming outdoor economy, and the increased demand for outdoor activities, due to the current Pandemic

With us here today is J.R. Burke, a representative from Polaris Inc., to speak directly to those new industry needs.
