Subject: Senate Bill 417—Permit Renewal Fees for Certain Solid Waste Disposal

Areas and Processing Facilities

Senate Bill 417 would establish new permit renewal fee limitations for solid waste disposal areas and processing facilities that are regulated by the federal government on the standards for the disposal of coal combustion residuals in landfills and surface impoundments.

Currently, such solid waste disposal areas and processing facilities have an annual permit renewal fee of at least \$1,000 but not more than \$4,000 based on a differential fee schedule adopted by the secretary based upon the characteristics of the disposal area sites.

SB 417 would amend the annual permit renewal fee to a minimum of \$12,000 and a maximum of \$16,000 as determined by the secretary in rules and regulations. The \$12,000 minimum fee would apply to such areas and facilities until a new fee schedule is adopted by the secretary. The first fees would be due on September 1, 2022.

SB 417 would take effect upon publication in the statute book.
