Subject: House Bill No. 2295

Summary

House Bill No. 2295 would exempt municipal motor grader vehicles from the Kansas Uniform Commercial Drivers' License Act requirements.

K.S.A. 8-2,125 through 8-1,142 contain the Kansas Uniform Commercial Drivers' License Act and the requirements for such act.

K.S.A. 8-2,127 provides exemptions for certain vehicles from the uniform act. This bill creates a new exemption for motor grader vehicles operated by an employee of a municipality if such employee is operating the motor grader vehicle within the boundaries of such municipality.

If enacted, the provisions of HB 2295 become effective July 1, 2021.
