I move to amend **House Substitute for SB 158**, as amended by House Committee, on page 45, in line 15, by striking "or"; in line 24, after "employment" by inserting ";

- (g) (1) (A) require an employer to allow an employee that is a first responder to register as a patient under section 8, and amendments thereto, for medical marijuana; or
- (B) prohibit an employer from taking any disciplinary action against an employee that is a first responder that uses medical marijuana.
 - (2) For the purposes of this subsection, "first responder" means any:
- (A) "Attendant" and "operator" as those terms are defined in K.S.A. 65-6112, and amendments thereto;
 - (B) "corrections officer" as defined in K.S.A. 75-5202, and amendments thereto; or
- (C) "law enforcement officer" as defined in K.S.A. 74-5602, and amendments thereto; or
- (h) require a correctional institution as defined in K.S.A. 75-5202, and amendments thereto, or a jail to provide medical marijuana to any inmate in such institution or person confined in such jail."
