In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 212 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 212 would authorize the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) to declare that certain immunizations required for admittance to a child care facility or school are no longer required if KDHE determines that the vaccines are unsafe. The bill would become effective upon its publication in the *Kansas Register*.
