HOUSE BILL No. 2046

By Robert G. (Bob) Bethell Joint Committee on Home and Community Based Services and KanCare Oversight

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AN ACT concerning home and community-based services; relating to the 1 2 intellectual or developmental disability waiver; increasing provider 3 reimbursement rates; making and concerning appropriations for the 4 fiscal years ending June 30, 2022, June 30, 2023, and June 30, 2024, 5 for the Kansas department for aging and disability services; directing 6 the Robert G. (Bob) Bethell joint committee on home and community 7 based services and KanCare oversight to study the waiting list for such 8 services.

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10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

11 Section 1. (a) Commencing in fiscal year 2025, and each fiscal year 12 thereafter, the Kansas department for aging and disability services shall 13 increase reimbursement rates for providers of home and community-based 14 services under the intellectual or developmental disability waiver provided 15 by section 1915(c) of the federal social security act compared to such reimbursement rates for the prior fiscal year by the greater of: 16

(1) 2%; or

18 (2) the annual percentage increase in the consumer price index for 19 urban wage earners and clerical workers for the immediately preceding 20 calendar year, as published by the United States department of labor.

21 (b) The Robert G. (Bob) Bethell joint committee on home and 22 community based services and KanCare oversight shall review the number 23 of individuals waiting to receive home and community-based services 24 under the intellectual or developmental disability waiver provided by 25 section 1915(c) of the federal social security act during the committee's 26 meetings in the third and fourth calendar quarters in 2021 and in January 27 and April in 2022. The committee shall make findings and 28 recommendations related to the committee's review and shall include such 29 findings and recommendations in the written report submitted in accordance with K.S.A. 39-7,160, and amendments thereto, at the 30 31 beginning of the 2022 and 2023 regular sessions of the legislature.
