AN ACT concerning wildlife; relating to wildlife violations; creating a violation and imposing penalties for taking wildlife simulated devices.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to take or attempt to take a wildlife simulated device that is being used by a law enforcement officer for the purpose of enforcing the wildlife laws of this state.
- (b) Upon conviction for a violation of this section, the penalty shall be the same as prescribed for the unlawful taking of the actual wildlife being simulated, excluding the penalties provided under K.S.A. 32-1032(b), and amendments thereto.
- (c) As used in this section, "wildlife simulated device" means any simulation or replication of wildlife, in whole or in part.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
