AN ACT concerning the state fire marshal; relating to law enforcement
powers thereof; fire equipment standards; requiring investigation of fire
deaths; amending K.S.A. 31-158 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 New Section 1. (a) The state fire marshal and investigators of the 7 state fire marshal shall have the authority to make arrests and conduct 8 searches and seizures while investigating violations of laws enforced or administered by the state fire marshal. Such investigators, who are 9 10 certified law enforcement officers pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5601 et seq., and 11 amendments thereto, shall be authorized to make arrests, conduct 12 searches and seizures and generally to enforce all criminal laws of the 13 state as-such investigators encounter violations of those laws-in the course of their employment are encountered by such employees during the 14 routine performance of their duties. 15

16 (b) Whenever the death of a person occurs as a result of fire, or when the body of a deceased person is discovered at the scene of a fire, an a 17 18 joint investigation regarding the circumstances of the death shall be 19 initiated by the chief of the organized fire department, regular or volunteer, 20 or and the chief law enforcement officer if no local fire department exists. 21 If there is no local fire department, the joint investigation shall be 22 initiated by the chief law enforcement officer and the state fire 23 marshal. The state fire marshal shall assist such official who initiates any 24 such investigation.

25 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 31-158 is hereby amended to read as follows: 31-158. 26 (a) No person shall knowingly sell or offer for sale in this state to any fire 27 department any item of clothing or equipment intended to protect 28 firefighters from death or injury while fighting fires unless the item of 29 clothing or equipment meets or exceeds the minimum standards 30 established for such item of clothing or equipment by in the standards of 31 the national fire protection association, in effect on the effective date of 32 this act designated by the state fire marshal by adoption of rules and 33 regulations.

(b) No fire department shall purchase in this state any item of
clothing or equipment intended to protect firefighters from death or injury
while fighting fires unless the item of clothing or equipment meets or

- exceeds the minimum standards established for such item of clothing or 1
- equipment by in the standards of the national fire protection association, in 2

 - (c) A violation of subsection (a) is a class B misdemeanor.
- (d) As used in this section, "fire department" means any city, county, 6 township or other public or private fire department. Sec. 3. K.S.A. 31-158 is hereby repealed. 7
