AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to teachers; requiring school
 districts to reimburse teachers for classroom supplies.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Each school year, the board of education of each school 5 district shall provide a reimbursement to teachers for classroom supplies in 6 7 an amount not to exceed \$250 for each teacher employed by the school district from the general fund of the school district. Reimbursement 8 9 moneys shall only be provided to teachers for documented purchases of 10 classroom supplies. All expenditures shall be submitted to the school 11 district treasurer who shall maintain an accounting of all reimbursement 12 expenditures.

(b) As used in this section:

(1) "Classroom supplies" means any item that may be used in
 providing education services and is intended to be fully used within the
 current school year. "Classroom supplies" does not include any food
 products, beverages or any equipment or other property that is intended for
 use over multiple school years.

(2) "Teacher" means a person who holds a certificate to teach and is
under contract to teach on a full-time basis for the current school year.
"Teacher" does not include any superintendent, principal, supervisor or
other persons employed under the authority of K.S.A. 72-1134, and
amendments thereto.
