## 2021 Kansas Statutes

- 47-1831. Animal health commissioner authorized to register original veterinary certificates and provide official calfhood vaccination tags. (a) The animal health commissioner is hereby authorized to:
- (1) Register original veterinary certificates of inspection for livestock, as defined in K.S.A. 47-1001, and amendments thereto; and
- (2) provide official calfhood vaccination tags and may require reimbursement for the actual cost of the tags. The commissioner may also charge a processing fee for such tags that shall not exceed \$.20 for each tag.
- (b) The commissioner shall determine the processing fee annually and shall fix such fee by rules and regulations.
- (c) The commissioner shall remit all moneys received by or for the commissioner under this section to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto.
