2021 Kansas Statutes

83-148. Liquefied petroleum gas; purchaser's credit for refilled or exchanged container, exceptions. Except as otherwise provided, when liquefied petroleum gas is sold by the container, either by a refilling of a container or an exchange of containers, the vendor shall give the purchaser full credit for the unused liquid remaining in a container being exchanged or refilled. The provisions of this section shall not apply to an exchange of containers when the exchanged container is delivered to the vendor by the purchaser. **History:** L. 1951, ch. 331, § 6; L. 1998, ch. 90, § 1; July 1.
